In August of 2019, the Ready Mixed Concrete Research and Education Foundation (RMC) released their latest collaboration with the National Concrete Pavement Technology Center (CPTech), <u>Guide to Concrete Trails</u>. This guide was written to assist local advocacy groups, designers, and contractors in all aspects of concrete trails. Topics covered include:
