In August of 2019, the Ready Mixed Concrete Research and Education Foundation (RMC) released their latest collaboration with the National Concrete Pavement Technology Center (CPTech), *Guide to Concrete Trails*. This guide was written to assist local advocacy groups, designers, and contractors in all aspects of concrete trails. Topics covered include:

- Developing a trail project and funding options.
- Criteria on selecting the type of trail design and how existing conditions influence design.
- ADA compliance in trail design.
- Construction methods of concrete trails.
- Rehabilitation of an existing trail with a concrete overlay.
- Planning for the maintenance of concrete trails.

The *Guide to Concrete Trails* follows the same format of the successful *Guide to Concrete Overlays of Asphalt Parking Lots* published in 2012, also brought to the construction industry by the RMC Foundation and written by CPTech.

Hansen is a member of the technical advisory committee for the *Guide to Concrete Overlays of Asphalt Parking Lots* and a contributing author to the *Guide to Concrete Trails*. In addition to his duties on the NRMCA Pave Ahead team, he writes for *Concrete InFocus* magazine and serves on the board of directors of American Society of Concrete Contractors (ASCC) and the NRMCA/ASCC Joint Paving Committee.
